YEAR 5 HERITAGE WALK – Wallabies class

Year 5 teachers are pleased to announce that, as part of our “Small Town – Big History” topic, we have arranged for the children to complete a “Heritage Walk” around Street. It will incorporate many historic landmarks and culminate at Millfield School.

Wallabies will walk on Thursday 7th October 2021

Children will take a guided walk during the morning, whilst completing activities and finding time to eat their mid-morning snack. We will head to Millfield School for the afternoon and complete further tasks and eat lunch in Millfield House.

No transport has been arranged for this visit and therefore pupils should meet at school on **Thursday 7th October**, for a 9.00 am registration and a prompt departure. As the visit culminates at Millfield school, we ask that children are collected from the Millfield School bus shelter in the **North Carpark at 2.45pm**. Alternative arrangements to bring children back to school have been made for those who use pre-arranged school transport or are booked into our After School Club.

The party leaders will be Mrs Moore and Mr Sansam assisted by Teaching Assistants.

As there is considerable walking involved, children are required to wear warm school clothing including a school jumper, preferably trousers, a coat and suitable walking shoes or trainers. Please check the weather conditions carefully on the day, to ensure your child is wearing appropriate clothing.

If your child is in receipt of a Free School Meal, a packed lunch will be provided for them. Please email office@brooksideacademy.co.uk if **THIS IS REQUIRED**. All other children will need to bring a packed lunch and refillable water bottle in an appropriate bag as they will need to carry their packed lunch for the duration of the trip.
