<p><b>Writing</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.</li> <li>• Re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Vocabulary, Grammar &amp; Punctuation</b></p>	<p>Capital letters, finger spaces and full stops</p>	

<p><b>Spelling &amp; Handwriting</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to sound out and spell CVC and CVCC words that are consistent with their phonics knowledge, including some tricky words.</li> <li>• Form all lower case and capital letters correctly.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Spoken Language</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participate in small group, class and 1:1 discussion, offering their own ideas using recently introduced vocabulary.</li> <li>• Offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems where appropriate.</li> </ul>
