**Year 1:** Tinned Fruit / Tinned Custard / Tinned Rice Pudding / Fruit Squash / Biscuits

**Year 2:** Tinned Soup / Tinned Baked Beans / Tinned Spaghetti/Ravioli

**Year 3:** Dried Rice / Dried Pasta / Instant Noodles / Jars of Pasta Sauces and Cooking Sauces

**Year 4:** Tinned Vegetables & Pulses / Tinned Tomatoes / Tinned Potatoes / Instant Mashed Potato

**Year 5:** Shower Gel / Shampoo / Toothpaste


