Dear Parents and Carers,

In After School Club (ASC) we are constantly looking to improve the experiences that children have. Since returning from the summer break, we have had a number of conversations with children and staff in ASC about the food we offer at teatime.

As a result of this we will be changing the menu options we offer starting the week commencing 30th October.

After the October half term (week commencing 30th October), children will still be provided with a tea. However, it will be in the form of a light tea, at a cost of £2.20. This will vary each day (excluding Friday) over a three-week cycle, with a new menu coming at the start of each new term.

The menu will be available on the school website under 'After School Club'. Meals will be made up of various food groups to ensure children are having grains, proteins and vegetables within their diet.
