/ Crisps and Snacks

Year 1: Shower Gel / Shampoo / Toothpaste

Year 2: Dried Rice / Dried Pasta / Instant Noodles / Jars of Cooking Sauces

Year 3: Tinned and Packet Soup / Tinned Baked Beans / Tinned Spaghetti/Ravioli

Year 4: Tinned Meat / Tinned Tuna / Strong Shopping Bags

Year 5: Tinned Peas/Carrots/Sweetcorn / Tinned Chickpeas/Kidney Beans / Tinned Tomatoes /
Tinned Potatoes / Instant Mashed Potato
