SPORTS DAY 2024

We are so excited to be able to welcome you to our Sports and Activity Day on **Thursday 13th June 2024**.

In the event of any postponements due to wet weather, our reserve dates are:

- Tuesday 25th June - 1st Reserve Sports Day
- Thursday 11th July - 2nd Reserve Sports Day

The timings for the day are:

- 9.15-10.00am – Early Years.
- 10.15 – 11:30am – Years 1 and 2, Kingfishers and Swifts
- 11.45 -12.30pm - Family whole school picnic lunch
- 12:45pm onwards – Years 3-6, Jays, Toucans, Robins and Hummingbirds.

All children can wear school sports kit for the whole day. Families are invited to join their children for a picnic lunch on the school field from 11:45 -12.30pm.

Please collect and sign out your child/ren from our school staff at the door you would normally drop off or pick up from. Please ensure that they return to the same place at 12.30pm. If you are unable to stay then please do not worry, children will have a picnic lunch with school staff who will ensure that they return to class.

On Sports Day, parents of children in Early Years to Year 2 who would normally enjoy the Universal Infant Free School Meal and those in Years 3-6 in receipt of a free school meal can order a packed lunch as we are not able to offer hot lunches on this day. Please order via Parent Pay where we will have adjusted the menu choice for that day. Children are welcome to bring in their own packed lunch should you prefer. ***Please note that if you have already ordered a meal for this date, you will need to go back into Parent Pay to select the packed lunch, as all previous orders have been deleted. In the event of sports day being postponed, children having family lunch MUST still bring in their own packed lunch as the kitchen will NOT BE ABLE to cook at short notice.***

Please ensure children have on sun cream and bring hats and water bottles for the day. In event of extremely hot weather conditions we will keep you updated with any adjustments needed to these arrangements.

Should the Key Stage 2 session finish before the end of the school day, children will be taken back to their classes to collect their belongings and you may take them early from their normal exit. You may then collect any younger siblings. If you are not collecting early, please pick up your child in the usual way at the end of the school day or from any after school club.
