- **Thursday 17th July – Brookside's Got Talent.** End of Year performance starting at 18:00. Children should arrive at 17:40 to change for the performance.

Instead of selling tickets this year, we will be asking for a donation at the performance towards a charity chosen by the House Captains.

Due to space being limited by the stage, we are able to accommodate 2 guests per Year 6 pupil at the performance. Please complete the reply slip overleaf stating how many seats you require. However, if you need more seats please request these on the reply slip and we will try our best to accommodate you once we know how many spare seats we have.

We would like to produce a programme for the performance. If you do not give consent for your child's first name to appear on the programme, please indicate on the reply slip.

We would like to thank you in advance for helping us prepare the children for their performance. We appreciate all of your support and are very excited about the performance.

- **Tuesday 22nd July – Swimming at Millfield.** Swimming and picnic at Millfield for pupils only (11:00-13:00).

We will walk down to the pool. Children will swim for 45 minutes from 11:45-12:30 and then have a picnic lunch. At 13:00 we will walk back to school. Please complete the reply slip overleaf to give permission for your child to attend this visit.

The children will need to bring their swimming kit, towel and packed lunch with plenty of water to drink. If your child requires a school lunch, please email their teacher by Friday 11th June.

This activity is being funded by Friends of Brookside, so there is no cost to parents.

Insurance: The Academy only provides cover against proven or agreed negligence by the Academy and its employees. Parents may wish to make their own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for their children.

Medical Needs: If your child has medical needs affecting him/her during the visit please inform the party leaders, in person or in writing, providing details.

- **Wednesday 23rd July – Leavers' Assembly and Presentation.** The assembly will begin at 13:45 and will be a formal opportunity for us, plus parents and carers, to say a farewell to our current cohort of Year 6 pupils.

We are able to accommodate up to 2 guests per Year 6 pupil. However, if you need more seats please request these on the reply slip and we will try our best to accommodate you once we know how many spare seats we have.

As part of our Year 6 leavers' assembly on Wednesday 23rd July, we would like to share a slideshow of the children to celebrate how they have changed from Early Years to Year 6. Therefore, we would be incredibly grateful if you were able to send in one photo of your child from when they were younger. 
