YEAR 2 EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO NOAH'S ARK ZOO FARM

We are planning a Year Two visit to Noah's Ark Zoo Farm on **Wednesday 5th November 2025**. The aim of the visit is for the children to investigate and explore the zoo, enjoying the experience of seeing a range of different animals. It will also support elements of our science curriculum through a talk with a zoo expert from their education department.

The party leaders will be Miss Stevens and Miss Garcia-Perez assisted by Teaching Assistants.

Our transport will be provided by Vickerys coaches. We aim to leave school by 9.10am and return to school by 3:10pm. Please can the children wear a school jumper with suitable trousers/leggings, sensible shoes and be prepared for all weather eventualities (rainproof jacket with hood or hats/suncream).

If your child is in receipt of a Universal Infant Free School Meal, a packed lunch can be provided for them. Please email office@brooksideacademy.co.uk **IF THIS IS REQUIRED – by Monday 27th October 2025.**

If you are providing your own packed lunch this should be in an appropriate bag, along with water in a water bottle. There will be a place for us to leave our bags during the day.

Financial Arrangements

- Parents are asked to make a voluntary contribution of **£16.65** towards the cost. Payment is through ARBOR. Please note, although this is called a 'voluntary contribution' we regret that the trip cannot go ahead unless all costs are covered. Payment needs to be paid by **Monday 20th October 2025** at the latest.
- In the event of the visit not taking place, parents will receive a refund.

- to cancel the visit should contributions not be forthcoming and sufficient funds are not received to meet the cost of the trip/activity
