Dear Parents and Carers,

**Year 6 Residential Visit to The Charterhouse Centre, from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

I am writing to confirm that there will be a residential trip for Year 6 next year.

The residential will be based at [The Charter House Centre](#) (near Cheddar in the Mendip Hills), it will be for 3 days with activities on all days, such as:

Caving, Archery, Low Ropes, Orienteering, Paddle Boarding, etc.

The residential will be led by teachers and assisted by support staff. The total cost of the visit is **£236.00** per child.

We need to pay a deposit in order to secure the booking. If you would like your child to attend, please ensure the **non-refundable deposit of £76.00** is paid on Arbor **by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2026**.

Further payments must be made by the following dates. *If payments are not received by each of the deadlines below, the Academy will regretfully assume your child is no longer attending the exciting adventure:*

1. **£40.00 by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2026** (deposit and 1<sup>st</sup> instalment = **£116.00**)
2. **£40.00 by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2026** (Remaining instalments balance = **£120.00**)
3. **£40.00 by 30<sup>th</sup> November 2026**
4. **£40.00 to make the full payment by the deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2027.**

***FYI - There will eventually be two Charterhouse trips listed against your child, as payments are crossing academic years, please pay the deposit and first payment initially. We will make the remaining payments available to pay as soon as we can should you wish to pay the whole amount or you can still pay in instalments.***

If you are struggling with payment, it is vital that you speak to Mr Walton as soon as possible. The Academy does not have funds to provide a residential, but the Academy aims for all children to take part in the Year 6 Residential.

**The Academy retains the following rights:**

- to withdraw any pupil at any stage from the above visit if deemed necessary;
  - to make changes to the above details subject to conditions;

- to cancel the visit should contributions not be forthcoming and sufficient funds are not received to meet the cost of the trip/activity. I

- **Insurance**

Brookside Academy only provides cover against proven or agreed negligence by the Academy and its employees. Parents may wish to make their own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for their children.

Nearer the time, we will hold a meeting about the residential, where you will be able to ask questions you may have, and hear about arrangements and preparation.
